

## **Regiment Meeting Minutes – June 17, 2008**

Meeting called to order at 7:06 pm.

Minutes from May meeting were read, accepted and approved.

Treasurer report – Jeff Uyak - Bank balance is \$1162.61. This does not include \$84.00 from last match raffle, a \$40.00 credit card membership, \$25.00 from tail gate tip jar.

Mr. Button to get check for \$57.40. This amount is what we owe him for button supplies after deducting membership dues.

Need to send check for \$250.00 to CCPR for shelter reservation as soon as Jeff gets the contract in the mail.

There are no outstanding checks.

**Hospitality Report** – Sara was absent so everyone talked about how well the tailgate went before the Atlanta match. It was decided that the next “official” tailgate will be on July 19<sup>th</sup>. This will be discussed in greater detail at our next regularly scheduled meeting on July 8<sup>th</sup>.

**Membership Report** – Jim via email – We have 51 members to date. The pins that were ordered should arrive any day now. Everything else is good.

**Old Business** – Bylaws will be discussed during the off season. Mikey has found some information on the Internet that can help guide us when we go to draft the bylaws.

**Game Day Ops** – Dieu – Working on table schedule for second half of season. If you anticipate any date you cannot work, please submit that date to Dieu as soon as you can.

**New Business** - Bus Trip – Bus will cost \$1350.00 this year. Last year it was \$1050.00. This was a price increase that we anticipated, so we weren't surprised by it. We will shoot to get a minimum of 30 riders. Ticket prices will be \$40.00 for Regiment members. \$50.00 for non-members. Match tickets are included in the bus ride price. If it comes up short, the Regiment will make up the difference. If we get more than 30 riders, that would be great, but we will have to limit the amount of riders to 40-45. The Regiment will buy a keg to cut down on the amount of large coolers on the bus. Jim is going to ask the bus company if the same driver is available to drive this year as well.

We need to start working on advertising the trip with flyers and P.A. announcements. We also need to talk it up at the table and hand out flyers from there as well as the gates?

The t-shirt idea for the Southern Derby matches didn't come to fruition this year, but we will definitely do it next year. Or we'll do scarves. Whatever we decide, we'll get started on it in plenty of time prior to the matches so things will be available AT the matches. ☺
